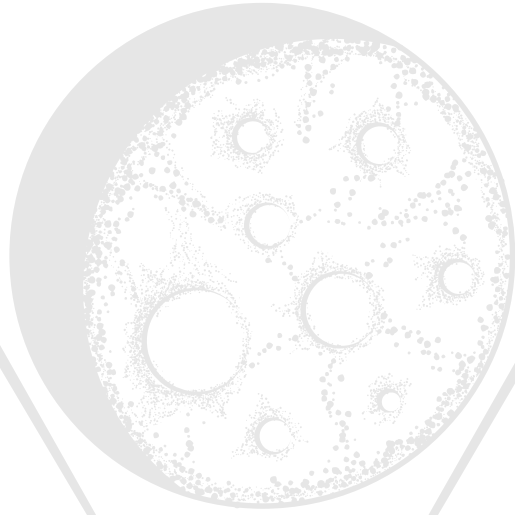

***BUT** please also be mindful of ongoing workshops and our keynote speaker!*

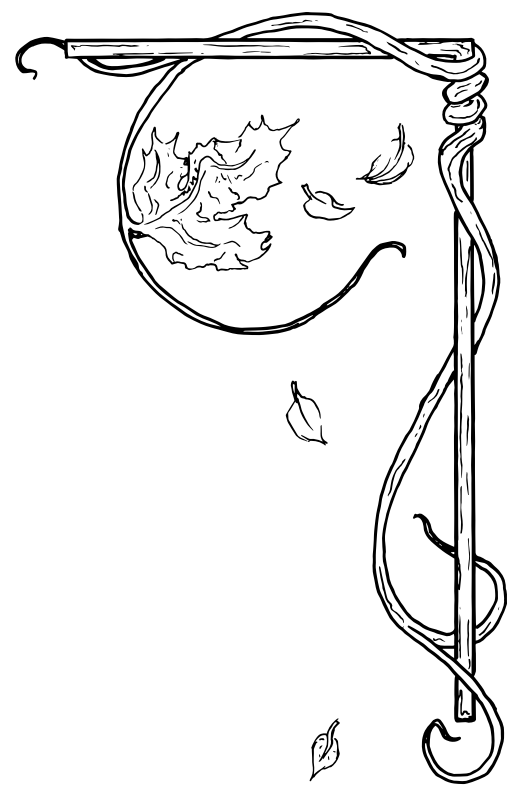
Our goal is to **SAFELY** and **RESPONSIBLY** drown them out with revelry while also promoting a positive image for the Pagan community.

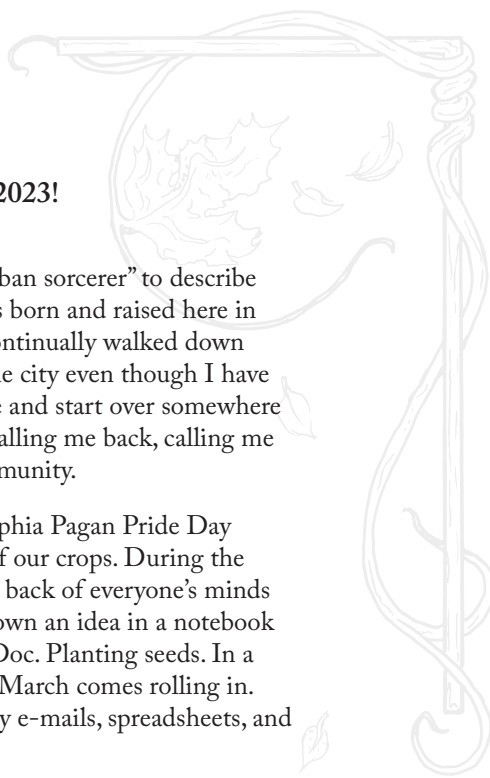

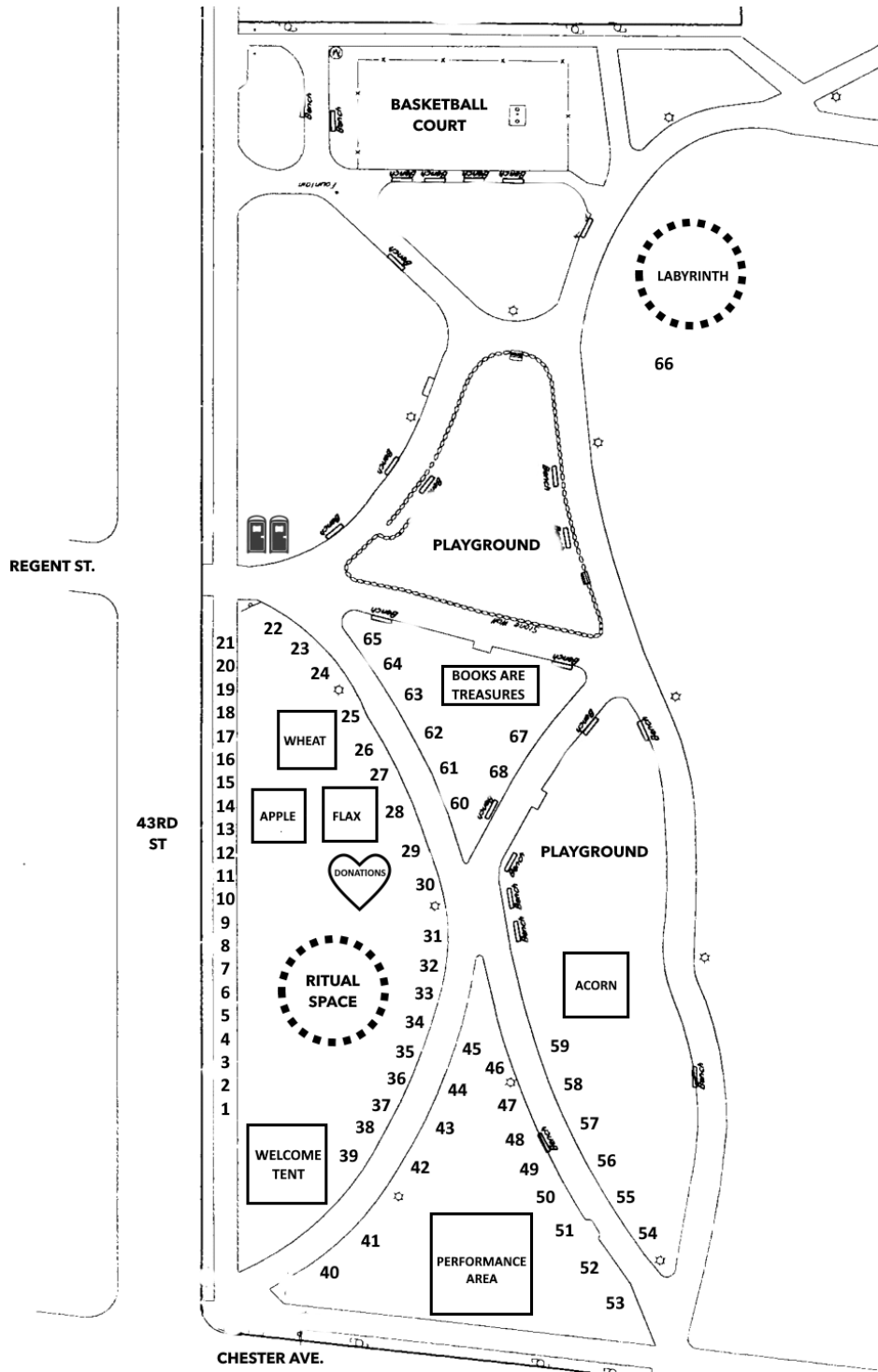

Introduction to Tea Leaf Reading

No longer lost in antiquity, allow tasseographer Rissa Miller to open up the enigmatic world of tea leaf reading. Guests will learn the basics of how to handle the tea and teacups, how to start seeing symbols and messages in the tea, and begin developing a personal collection of symbols for readings. The session will include a brief history of tea leaf reading, traveling the Silk Road, sharing parlors with Victorian Spiritualists, and even explaining the basics of scrying. Then the most critical part of the process: offering insight on how to interpret symbology, and learning to trust your own intuition when you see patterns in the chaos. And the most exciting part—all this new knowledge extends beyond the tea cup into everyday life, seeing signs, and trusting in our inner knowing.

The Goddess in the Labyrinth

The Labyrinth is an ancient pattern of power that is walked by foot or traced by hand... This 4,000 year old complex form symbolizes balance, the inward journey, inner wisdom, healing, wholeness, the spiritual journey. The labyrinth is a container; it embodies the womb of Mother Earth, the fertile womb that gives birth... She is Ariadne, the goddess of the labyrinth; The Divine Androgyne, the God, The archetypal spiral.. As a metaphor, the labyrinth is symbolic of our life's journey. In this workshop, we will discuss the labyrinth journey, assert ourselves as conduits for transformation and evoke deity within this sacred pattern. Experience this ritual of the labyrinth, and charge your inner god/goddess, while opening the labyrinth through song, chant, dance, poetry, and the walk.

Día de los Muertos: Paper Flower Crafting

Día de Muertos (Day of the Dead), a pre-Hispanic tradition spanning back thousands of years, traces back to the Aztec goddess Mictecacihuatl. A celebration of life in death, *ofrendas* (altars with offerings) are central, with marigolds (*cempasúchil*, or *flor de muerto*) and other flowers. The flowers honor and guide the spirits and also symbolize the sun, the fragility of life, and bring cheerfulness. Paper flowers represent these altar flowers and we will craft them here together.
